



RAM Focus Countries – Progress

With other Donors, RAM has contributed to:

- Solomon Islands
- 87% reduction, 2 provinces at pre-elimination stage.

indigenous malaria with 9 imported cases.

PNG 65% (to 90%) reduction; elimination programs planned.

East Timor Timor Leste >99% reduction working toward malaria free status by 2021. In 2019, the country has ZERO

Solomon Islands RAM Record of Service:

- >200,000 Bed nets, Flip charts and brochures, larvacide & IRS.
- LLIN procurement for the Global fund.
- 21 Houses constructed for MoH malaria staff and microscope diagnosis.
- 13 Storage sheds for LLINs.
- 20 boats and several vehicles to assist LLIN distribution.
- 160 villages provided with tools (\$250,000).



By 2019, RAM PNG has distributed more than 12 million bed nets funded by The Global Fund









- Accurate <u>stratification</u> to map malaria risks locations, nets access, entomological surveys
- Sustained malaria control measures
- Monitor drug and insecticide resistance
- A reliable field test for asymptomatic carriers
- Multi valent vaccine
